COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION 1.6 Seed Loan Program









The purpose of this program is to promote financial independence and help disabled persons living in slums to earn their livelihood and improve their quality of life. The beneficiaries of this program are exclusively persons with disabilities who are needy and want to be self-reliant. With the help of Seed Loan, they either purchase additional material for their respective enterprise or start a new enterprise which helps them to increase their monthly income.

During the quarter under report, one PwD beneficiary, namely, Ms. Bhagyashree, 21 years of age having physical disability, from Nanhe Park community was provided Seed Loan to purchased raw material for stitching of cloths for her petty boutique shop located in the community. The total number of beneficiaries under Seed Loan program is now 143.




