COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Under the CBR Program, ASRA extended its services to **842+** beneficiaries spread over **11 communities**. The present staff strengths under CBR program is **22**

- Medical Intervention & therapeutic Services were provided to over **253** beneficiaries
- Under CBR Education program: **220** children are learning education out of which there are **27** CwDs.
- Under Vocational Trainings Program: **60** students are getting vocational trainings.
- Seed Loan Program: **02** beneficiaries received Seed Loan & **03** more have been identified.
- Online applications were applied for: over **39** C/PwDs.
- Beneficiaries covered under psychometric assessment & psychotherapy project: over **175** C/PwDs
- Beneficiaries who were provided with skills development training in Art & Craft & Artificial Jewellery Making **93** beneficiaries in **9** communities

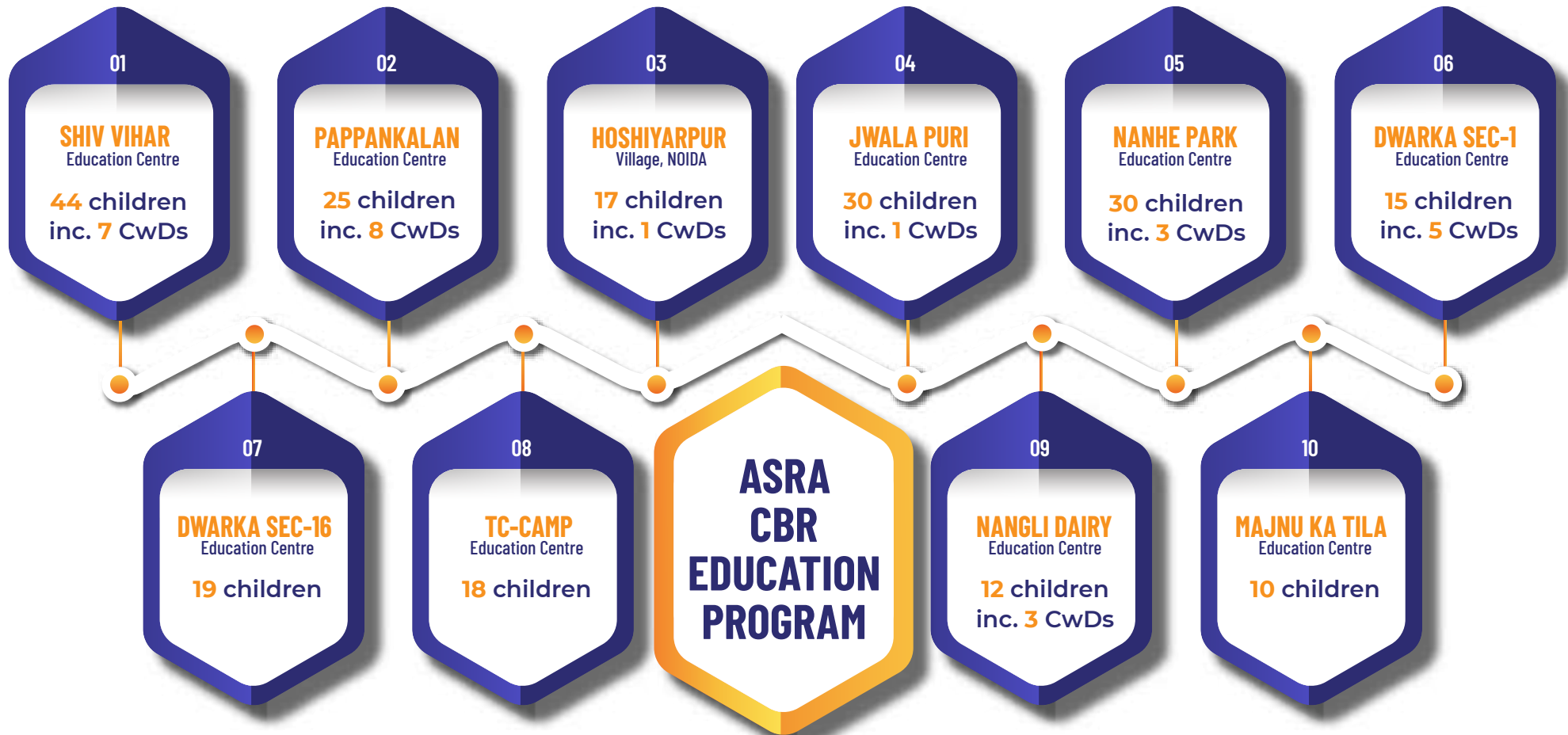


EMPOWERING THE NEXT GENERATION

Social Mapping of children/persons with disabilities in CBR, AIRTC Special School & ARTC is being done with an objective to do their socio-economic assessment eventually leading towards their inclusion in society. Simultaneously, online applications were continuously filled by ASRA CBR Team, for those, who were uneducated, or ignorant of how to apply through online process to avail Government facilities.

During the quarter under report, ASRA CBR Team applied online for Government facilities for 39 C/PwDs

01 COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION

Seed Loan Program



The purpose of this program is to promote financial independence and help disabled persons living in slums to earn their livelihood and improve their quality of life. With the help of Seed Loan, they either purchase additional material for their respective enterprise or start a new enterprise which helps them to increase their monthly income.

During the quarter under report, 2 PwD beneficiaries received Seed Loan. The total number of beneficiaries under Seed Loan program is now 145.



SARITA AND BHAGYASHREE

Sarita Sharan is a dedicated mother who has been part of the ASRA community for 10 years. Through ASRA's seed loan program, Sarita has been able to create a stable and promising future for her family. Her daughter Bhagyashree, who is differently abled, thrives in the supportive environment at ASRA, where she receives the education and care she needs.



BANTI LAL

Banti Lal, a 40-year-old man with an orthopedic disability (OH), had always faced struggles in finding stable work to support his family. Living in Dwarka Sector-01, he found limited opportunities. However, his determination to be self-reliant never wavered. Through ASRA's Community-Based Rehabilitation (CBR) program, Banti received a seed loan on July 29, 2024, to purchase a Juki tailoring machine.

01 COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION

Psychometric Assessment & Psychotherapy (Under Mental Health Project)



This innovative initiative under Mental Health Project screens, assesses, and supports young people with intellectual disabilities, providing much needed specialized care by a highly qualified team of psychologist.

Simultaneously, individual / group counseling is provided to them and their family members, which is aimed towards inducting & training them in **Activity of Daily Living (ADL)**. Based on the capabilities and interest of the beneficiaries suitable and appropriate vocational and social skill training is also imparted to the beneficiaries.

02 AIRTC : ASRA SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

ASRA INTERVENTION, RECREATION AND THERAPY CENTRE (AIRTC)



In AIRTC, apart from special education, all students enrolled in AIRTC are getting comprehensive rehabilitation which includes assessment by Orthopedic Surgeon and customized, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy and Prosthetics & Orthotics by qualified professionals.

The students enrolled in AIRTC have different types of disabilities, predominantly intellectual disabilities associated with physical & speech & hearing impairments.

During the reported quarter, **17 children** with special needs attended ASRA Special school

03 MEDICAL INTERVENTION & THERAPEUTIC SERVICES AT CBR, AIRTC AND ARTC



3.1 ASSESSMENT CLINIC

Assessment clinic consists of **Senior Orthopedic Surgeon** who visits ASRA once a week since May 2022 and a team of experts/ professionals comprising of **Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapist, Speech Therapist, Special Educators, Prosthetic & Orthotic Engineer & Psychologist etc.**

After a thorough assessment is made, the patient is evaluated for specific treatment with specified duration. Later they are referred to the concerned department of ARTC or other hospitals and Rehab Centers for the needful treatment both from the surrounding areas and adopted communities.

Total Number of patients assessed during the quarter: 57

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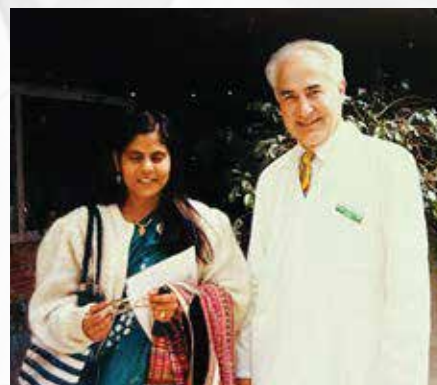
