4. SEED LOAN PROGRAM

During the quarter under report, 2 PwD beneficiaries received Seed Loan. The total number of beneficiaries under Seed Loan program is now 145.

Sarita Sharan, a dedicated mother in the ASRA community for 10 years, used ASRA's seed loan program to build a stable future for her family. Her differently abled daughter, Bhagyashree, thrives at ASRA, receiving the education and care she needs.



BANTI LAL

Banti Lal, a 40-year-old man with an orthopedic disability, struggled to find stable work in Dwarka. On July 29, 2024, through ASRA's CBR program, he received a seed loan to buy a Juki tailoring machine, enabling him to become self-reliant.
